### **Resources:**

- CMS, 2020: “In the CY 2020 Physician fee Schedule (PFS) final rule, we adopted simplified medical record documentation requirements for physicians and certain nonphysician practitioners to allow the billing clinician to review and verify, rather than redocument, information added to the medical record by any member of the health care team. During the public health emergency, this principle applies across the spectrum of all Medicare-covered services, and will also apply to therapists so that they may review and verify, rather than redocument, notes added to the medical record by any other member of the health care team, including therapy or other students.”
