

TRUST OVERVIEW & CHECKLIST FOR E-23

Use this checklist as an overview to successfully complete TRUST requirements and other tasks.

GET STARTED IMMEDIATELY (MARCH – APRIL 2023)

- Create UW NetID & Password
- Complete TRUST Compliance Requirements by **April 14th**

Prior to the Start of the First Summer Experience (FSE): (APRIL – MAY 2023)

- Login to [E23 TRUST Longitudinal Canvas Site](#)
 - Use UW NetID & PW to login
 - Canvas Link: <https://canvas.uw.edu/courses/1650895>
- Review these modules on Canvas:
 - Orientation Module
 - First Summer Experience (FSE) Module
 - Underserved Pathway (UP) Module
- TRUST Graduation Requirement Acknowledgement Form – Read and submit by **April 30th**
- Submit TRUST Bio sheet and email a copy to your Regional Administrator to send to your Preceptor
- Complete assignments in the UP module



During & After FSE: (MAY – JULY 2023)

- Review FSE module on Canvas and print out FSE assignments ahead of time. Complete the following 4 assignments while at your TRUST site:
 - Walk Around Discovery Tool Assignment
 - Meet Your Continuity Clinic Healthcare Team and Community Assignment
 - FSE Reflection – Patient Interview Assignment
 - FSE Reflection – TRUST First Summer Experience Assignment
- FSE Evaluation Survey (Complete at the end of your FSE **no later than 1 week after your FSE**. Link provided at the end of FSE module)

Prepare for RUOP (OCTOBER 2023 – JANUARY 2024)

- Review the Rural Underserved Opportunities Program (RUOP) module on Canvas
- Attend Triple I Poster Session and/or RUOP Info Session at your Foundations Campus (Oct – Nov)
- Apply for RUOP/WRITE (December 2023 - January 2024)
 - *Note: TRUST students complete a combined RUOP/WRITE application*

MHS 1 & Integration, Term 2 (MARCH 2024 – MAY 2024)**

- TRUST students may have the opportunity to complete the Medicine, Health & Society (MHS) I course while out at their TRUST continuity sites either the week before or after spring break (3/11 – 3/22/24)
- TRUST students may have the chance to return to their TRUST sites for Integration week, Term 2 (5/6 – 5/10/24)

RUOP (JUNE 24TH – AUGUST 23RD 2024)

- RUOP is a 6-week scholarship program that includes a 4-week clinical immersion experience at your TRUST site. Each student will have their own personal start date tailored to their Preceptor's availability. Students should expect to spend 30-35 hours in clinic during the 4-weeks and the rest of the time completing weekly Canvas assignments. All assignments geared toward the creation of an academic poster that is presented at your Foundation campus in Fall 2024.

WWAMI TRUST Leadership Retreat (AUGUST 2024)

- Attend WWAMI TRUST Leadership Retreat *tentatively scheduled* for 8/21/24 – 8/24/24
 - It is an expectation that all TRUST Scholars attend this retreat.

Integration, Term 3 (MARCH 2024 – MAY 2024)*

- TRUST students may have the chance to return to their TRUST sites for Integration week, Term 3 (11/4 – 11/8/24).

Prepare for STEP 1 and WRITE / Patient Care Phase (JANUARY – MARCH 2025)

- Review WRITE module on Canvas
- Receive Patient Care Phase schedule
- Prepare and take Step 1
- Patient Care Phase begins Spring Quarter 2025
- COMPLETE: End of Foundations Evaluation Survey (February – March 2024)**

WRITE / Patient Care Phase (MARCH 2025 – FEBRUARY 2026)

- WRITE encompasses two quarters (21 to 24 weeks) during the Patient Care Phase. Timeframes for when a student will be at their WRITE site may vary from year to year. Refer to the [WRITE Program Calendar](#) page for current information.

TRUST Graduation (MAY 2027):

- Sign Up for TRUST Connections Alumni database (optional)
- Send Rural Programs mailing address for after graduation
- COMPLETE: Graduation Evaluation Survey (April – May 2027)**
