

## Ambulatory Scripts: Congestive heart failure/Cardiomyopathy

<b>Type</b>	Ischemic vs non-ischemic &/OR diastolic vs systolic
<b>Labs</b>	BNP baseline, LFTs
<b>Studies</b>	Most recent echo summary (EF %, structural, valvular) Other recent study results: EKG, CXR, BNP bump
<b>Function</b>	NYHA class 3 or 4 , If (EF <35% Ø NYHA 4) +/- AICD
<b>+/- meds</b>	BB, ACEi/ARB, diuretic, statin, ASA (dose)
<b>+/- recent exacerbation</b>	EKG, CXR, BNP, trop Meds required: diuretics, nitrates, O2
<b>ROS</b>	+/- exertional dyspnea, orthopnea, PND, bloating/edema, abdominal pain
<b>Vitals</b>	+/- wt changes, RR, BP, PR, (abnormal or considering med changes)
<b>PE</b>	rate/rhythm m/g/r, edema, CTAB/crackles, laterally displaced PMI, s3, JVD, hepatosplenomegaly, fluid wave/shifting
