History	5 Ps 1. Partners 2. Practices 3. Protection from STIs 4. Past History of STIs 5. Pregnancy Intention Past or current methods Side effect tolerance (bleeding, hormones)
Social Hx	(tobacco use, work/school schedule that might impact adherence)
PMHx	HTN, DM, renal disease, migraines, cancer
Medications	any potential drug interactions, WHO eligibility criteria
Studies	pregnancy testing
Patient Education	Start plan, back up method, if low reliability method provision of Plan B and PNV
