Clinic: All primary care clinics are located in a new facility. This enhances the breadth and depth of the student experience. Many physicians have embraced "open access scheduling" which promotes creativity and satisfaction. Extending the student's rotation into the hospital's Radiology Department and ED broadens your exposure to the continuum-of-care. The new clinics enjoy well-appointed reception areas and a full staffing complement to support services in the clinic setting. Procedure rooms are utilized for minor procedures not requiring conscious sedation.

Medical Experience

Nursing Home: Powell Valley Healthcare offers Powell Valley Care Center, a 99-bed nursing home that is adjacent to the hospital. The center also includes an assisted living facility, and a home health agency.

Hospital: Powell Valley Healthcare, Inc. offers an integrated delivery system in this rural setting. Powell Valley Hospital is a 25-bed acute care facility. All services are provided in an extended campus setting, which allows for maximal access to care for patients and health professionals. Powell Valley Hospital averages 18 deliveries per



month and 70-90 surgery cases per month. The average daily census is 12 patients. There are 25 active medical staff members, with a total of 82 medical staff and allied health professionals credentialed in all categories.
