2022 Guiding Principles Per 2020 Working Group/Curriculum Committee

- 1. Foundations should be longer
- 2. Blocks should be \leq 8 weeks and more uniform in length
- 3. Hematology should be earlier & before cardiovascular
- 4. HFF complexities deserve special attention when constructing the schedule
- 5. Threads need a larger and more integrated presence in blocks
- 6. Set time aside during Foundations for review & integration
- 7. Consider burden of disease when determining depth of coverage
- 8. Give more time to B&C, MSK, Immunology & threads
