Edith and Meghan have been working with blocks and threads to ensure content has a home and reflects the guiding principles approved by Curriculum Committee. This has involved meeting with thread directors and reviewing their content, current hours, and requested hours and content in depth. These requests were then balanced with the needs of the blocks by getting input from block directors to help guide hours allocations within each block. We also have worked with the Themes and Oncology leads to review their longitudinal content needs.
