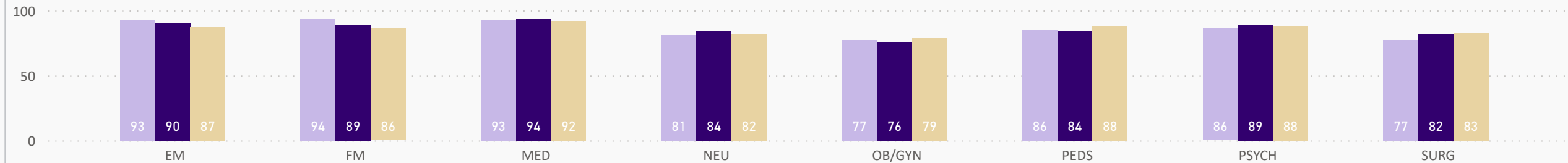

(% of Very often/Always)

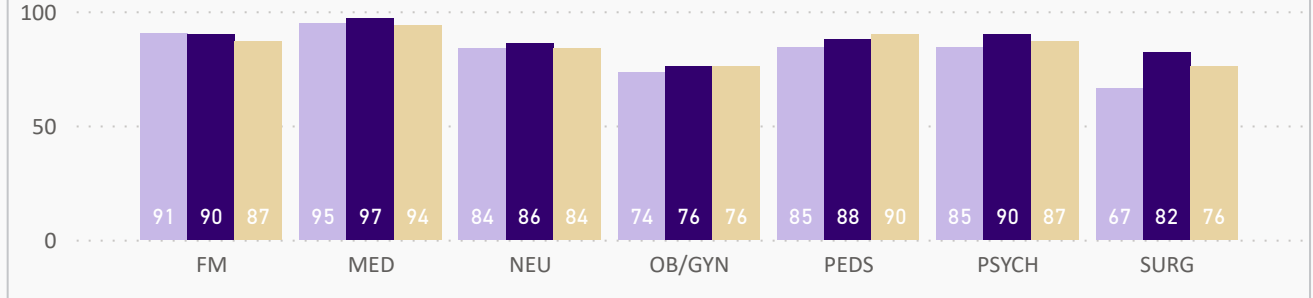

(% of Agree/Strongly agree)

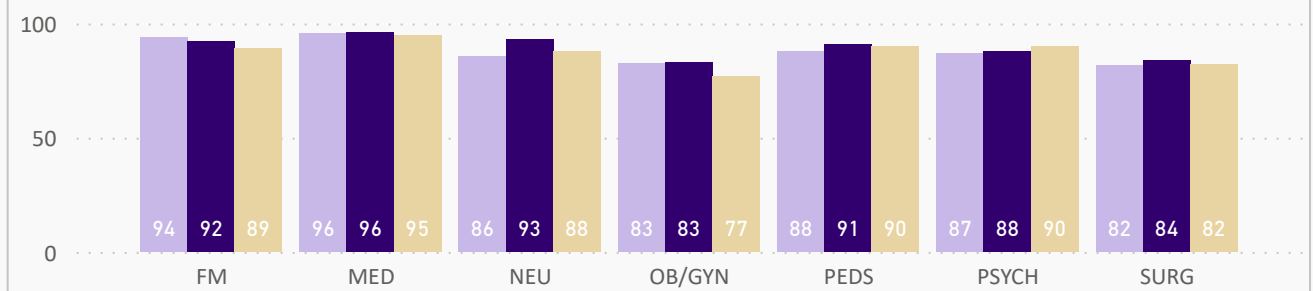

(% of Agree/Strongly agree)

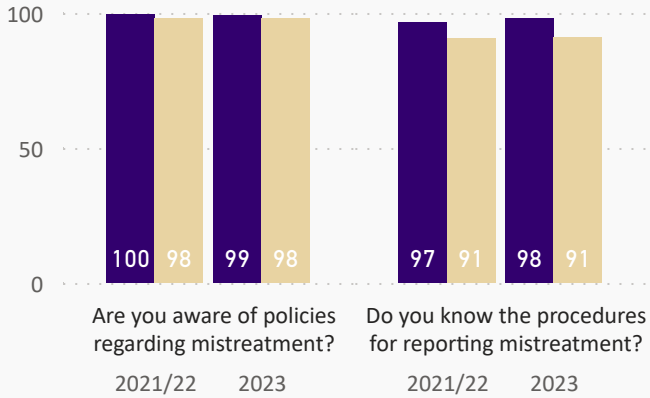

(% of Once/Occasionally/Frequently)

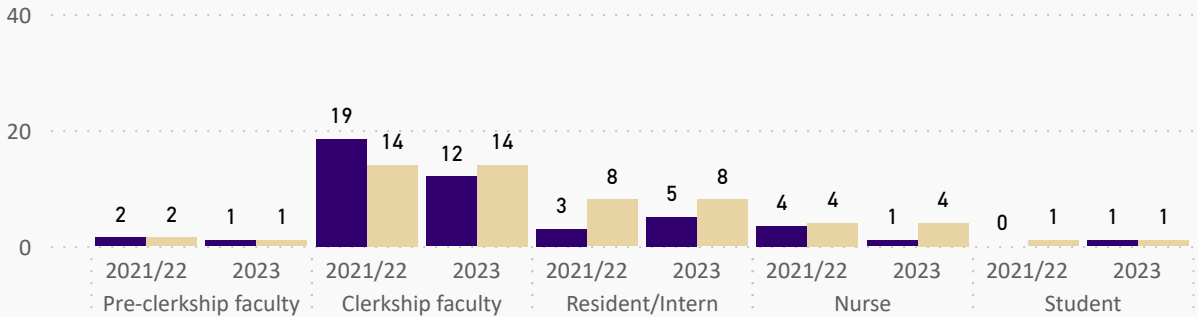

(% of Respondents)

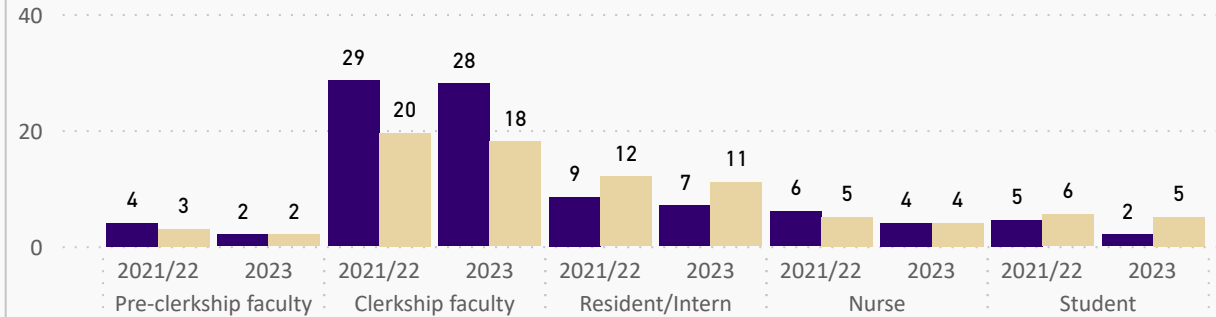

(% of Respondents)

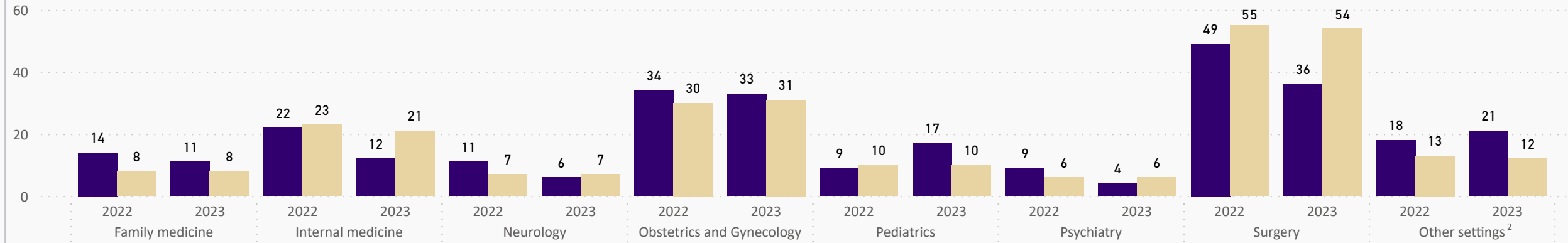

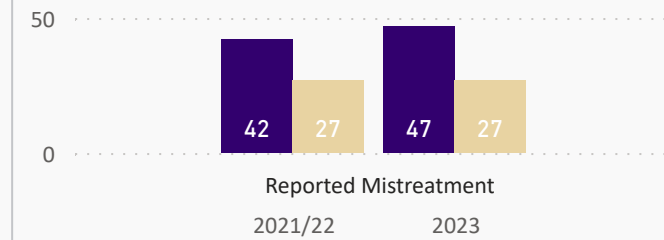

(% of Respondents, n= 72)³

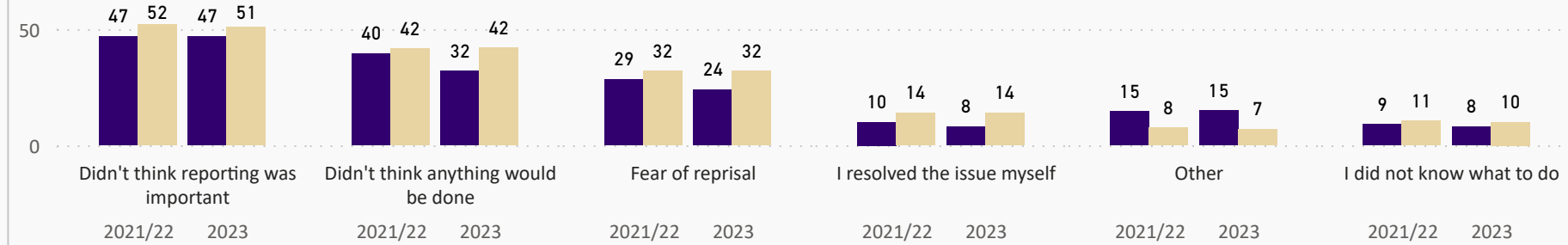

(% of Respondents, n= 34)⁴

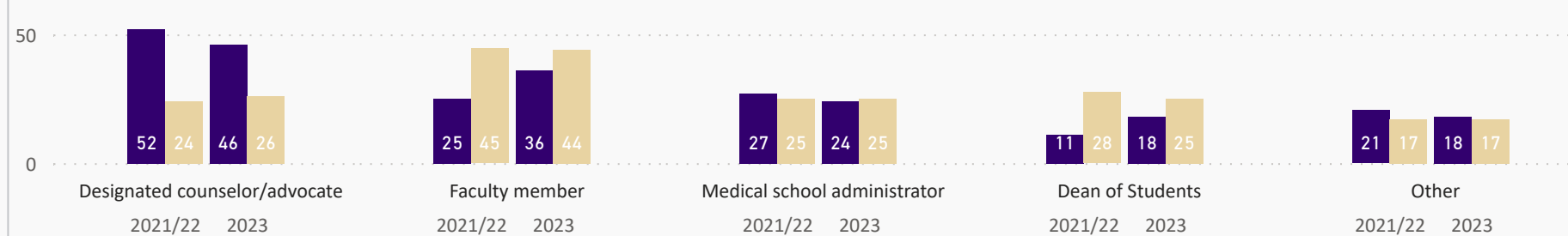
