- Mentor high school and undergraduate students interested in a health career
- Receive mentorship and/or training from a faculty
- Receive a \$1,000 stipend

- Nursing (BSN, MSN, DNP, PhD)
- Dentistry (DDS, DMD)
- Pharmacy (PharmD)
- Physician Assistant (MPAS)
- Public Health (MPH, PhD)

\*Students must have two years remaining in their program to participate.
