## **Checklist for MS1 Remediation**

- Students remediating more than one block: Contact Dr. Sprenger (cts2501@uw.edu) and somiii@uw.edu to discuss your plan for a modified III project.
- Seattle and Spokane students: Register for Summer Quarter courses:
  - MEDSCI 501 Independent Investigative Inquiry (III)
  - MEDSCI 524 Medicine, Health, and Society II (MHS II)
  - The independent study course(s) needed for your remediation
- Alaska, Idaho, Montana, and Wyoming students: Confirm with your <u>Site Admin</u> that you are correctly registered with your home campus for remediation.
- **By July 1**, schedule a meeting with the Block/Thread Director to:
  - Ask them to share their expectations, remediation content, and designated faculty contact.
  - $\Box$  Ask them to share the remediation exam format.
  - $\Box$  Develop a study plan.
- Schedule a meeting with a tutor at least once a week to review material.
- By the end of the second week of Summer Quarter, email <u>somtests@uw.edu</u> and the Block/Thread Director the date of your remediation exam. Note: Remediation exams will only be given on Fridays.

- Schedule a meeting with a learning specialist at least once to review study strategies.
- Schedule a mid-quarter check-in with designated faculty, if needed.
- By the last day of UW Summer Quarter, complete your remediation exam.
