

Checklist for MS1 Remediation

- Students remediating more than one block: Contact Dr. Sprenger (cts2501@uw.edu) and somiii@uw.edu to discuss your plan for a modified III project.
- Seattle and Spokane students: Register for Summer Quarter courses:
 - MEDSCI 501 – Independent Investigative Inquiry (III)
 - MEDSCI 524 – Medicine, Health, and Society II (MHS II)
 - The independent study course(s) needed for your remediation
- Alaska, Idaho, Montana, and Wyoming students: Confirm with your [Site Admin](#) that you are correctly registered with your home campus for remediation.
- By July 1**, schedule a meeting with the Block/Thread Director to:
 - Ask them to share their expectations, remediation content, and designated faculty contact.
 - Ask them to share the remediation exam format.
 - Develop a study plan.
- Schedule a meeting with a tutor at least once a week to review material.
- By the end of the second week of Summer Quarter**, email somtests@uw.edu and the Block/Thread Director the date of your remediation exam. Note: Remediation exams will only be given on Fridays.
 - RUOP students: Account for your Clinical Experience schedule (July-August) while choosing your exam date.
- Schedule a meeting with a learning specialist at least once to review study strategies.
- Schedule a mid-quarter check-in with designated faculty, if needed.
- By the last day of UW Summer Quarter**, complete your remediation exam.
