You can also remind them to refrain from signing up for non-clinical electives, preceptorships, or shadowing experiences that conflict with their classes or required activities. This includes EXAMS, anatomy labs, blocks or classes, college hospital tutorials, clinical skills, primary care practicum, and Medicine Health & Society I or II. Please contact the non-clinical elective course director for permission to accommodate an occasional absence from the elective if their schedule allows them to attend most of the assigned elective class times.

EXAMS: If there are any exam conflicts with their chosen elective, then the exam MUST take precedence---SOM exams cannot be missed to attend any elective coursework.
